SET BUILDER

Question, what brings a show to life? Answer, the sets and scenery of course! You could be part of that special magic by joining our team of set building volunteers and creating sets, bringing to life that unique space where the action takes place, enhancing the performance and adding a another level of enjoyment to the show.

What's involved?

- Working with the director and performers to create their vision
- Helping devise creative sets for the performances
- Constructing and installing sets, and dismantling them after the performance ends
- Building and painting props and backcloths
- Occasional help with simple building maintenance

This role will suit people who

Have an interest in woodwork and practical DIY skills. Enjoy building and painting props etc., working as part of a team to strict deadlines and, importantly, have a sense of humour. This role can be physically demanding, so a reasonable level of fitness is required.

What's in it for you?

Fun (although it's hard work), and a chance to use both your practical and creative skills. The opportunity to experience the back stage camaraderie with teammates and work in a unique environment, learning skills from theatre professionals.
